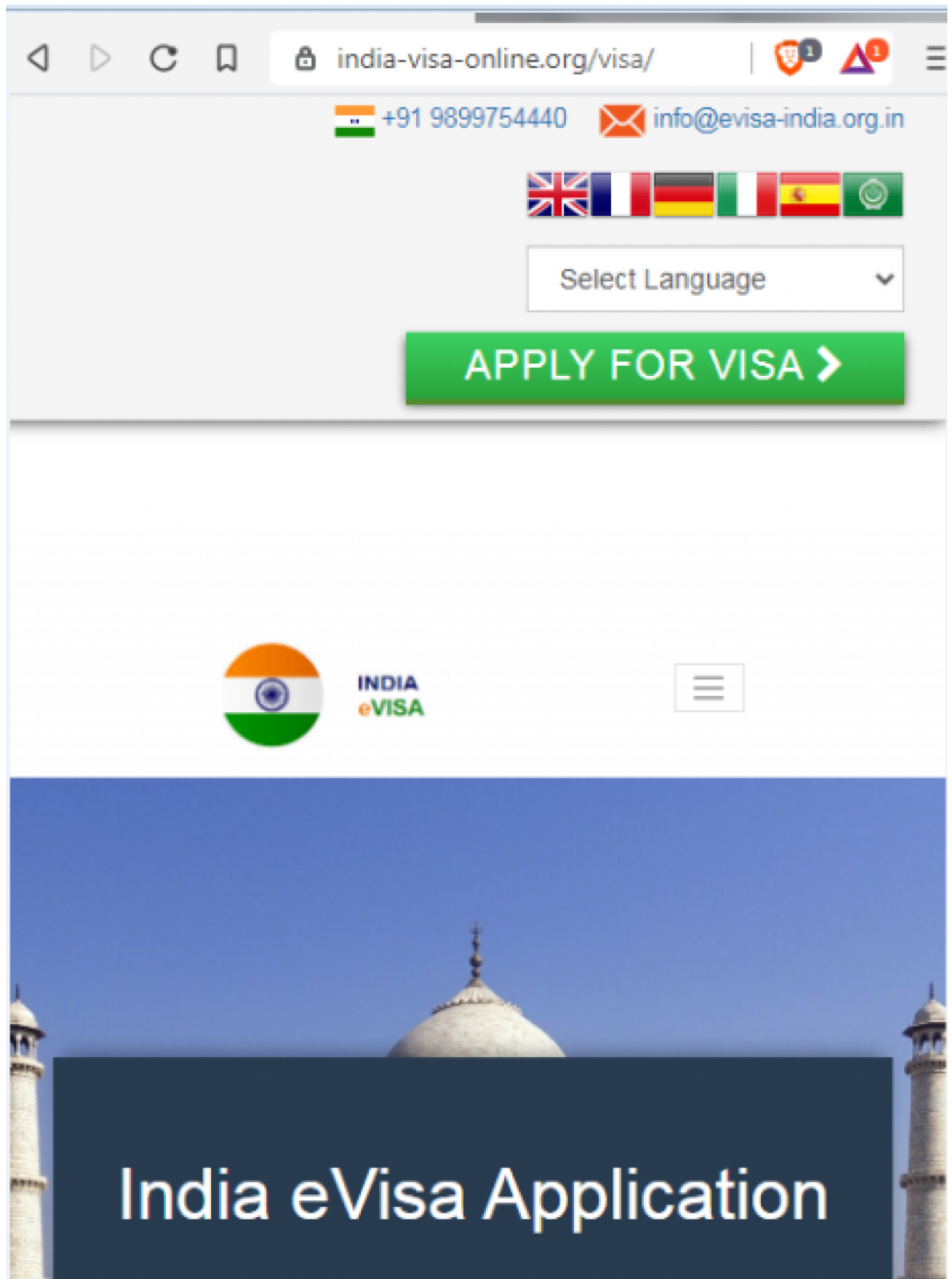


Indian e-Visa Allows Travelers to Visit the Country in an Easier Way for Short Stays

New Delhi, Delhi Mar 27, 2023 (IssueWire.com) - Entering the country of culture, India requires a passport and a visa for travelers. Now with the Indian e-Visa program visitors can obtain the visa online and would not require to physically visit the Indian embassy. A total of 166 countries can obtain the Indian e-Visa and the country for a short visit which now allows Belgian citizens to get the visa and visit the country. **Indian Visas for Belgian Citizens** can be for three purposes, tourism, business, or media e-Visa. Apart from the tourists, business, and medical e-Visa for India, there is also an Indian e Transit visa which lets the visa holder transit through India. All non-visa-exempt travelers must get this transit e-Visa if they will be at an Indian airport for more than 24 hours or if they want to leave the transit area. The Indian e-Visa program by the government has made it easier for citizens of Oman to enter the country for a short stay. To get the **Indian Visa for Oman Citizens**, the list of required documents is also kept minimal. Citizens would need to have a valid passport a clear and current photo size of the passport, along with a scanned copy of the passport's information page. People who are traveling for business purposes would require to submit a business card or letter of invitation, and applicants traveling for medical purposes would need to have a letter from the Indian facility where the treatment or the surgery will be provided. Similarly, an approved application for the **Indian Visa for Japan Citizens** would require a valid payment method, a credit card, a debit card, or a PayPal account which will let them stay for up to 180 days for tourism and up to 60 days for medical or business purposes.
