# **Murrah Buffalo Body**

The body of the buffalo is broad, muscular, and wedge-shaped. The legs are relatively short, but they are powerful. The Murrah buffalo has silky smooth skin and minor hair. An average male Murrah buffalo weighs about 550 kg, whereas an average female weighs about 450 kg. A male and female Murrah buffalo are 1.42 metres and 1.32 metres tall, respectively.

# **Buffalo Age**

An average Murrah buffalo lives 11 to 12 years. The fourth lactation is when the buffalo's ability to produce milk peaks and each subsequent lactation sees a drop. A buffalo's pregnancy lasts, on average, 310 days.

#### **Cost of Murrah Buffalo**

The Murrah buffalo price may range from Rs 50,000 to Rs 1,30,000 depending on the physical characteristics and features of the animal. Buffalo characteristics that affect the price include size and structure, milk output, lactation cycle, and genetic buffalo.

### Milk production capacity

The female Murrah calf can start giving milk in 36 to 48 months if given the right care. They raise their prices for the same reason. They are more adapted to the climate in South India. We need to be cautious throughout the summer because it's conceivable for some regions to have extremely high temperatures. It could take some time for a Murrah buffalo bought in Punjab or Haryana to adjust to life in South India.

### Milk Fat Percentage Existence:

Murrah buffalo contribute between 6.5 and 9% of the milk's fat content. Because this type of buffalo has silent heat, it is best to notice it. After heat is found, it must be crossed with a bull or artificially fertilised to become pregnant.

## **Right Time to Purchase**

Buying in the winter is less expensive because most animals give birth then; believing in the summer is more expensive since fewer buffaloes are available. The demand for dairy goods like ice cream and buttermilk rises in the summer.

# **Tips to Take Care of Murrah Buffalo**

#### **Shelter**

Every cattle needs a comfortable atmosphere for optimum functioning. One of the most crucial components in protecting your milk is shelter. Don't expose buffalo to intense sunshine, rain, ice and snow, parasites, or predators.

Ensure that the shelter housing your buffalo has clean air and water. There must be ample space and an open area for food and water for cattle to eat quickly. Drain pipes must be 7 cm deep and 40 cm in diameter.

# **Care During Pregnancy**

Better management will result in a good calf and increased milk production, so you must pay your cattle more care. A pregnant buffalo should receive an additional 1 kg of grain as she matures physically.

### **Management and Calf Care**

Rinse your mouth and nose of mucous right away after giving birth. If the calf isn't breathing, try using your hands to squeeze and relax its chest to see if artificial respiration is necessary. Tie the naval 2 to 5 cm away from the body to cut the umbilical cord. Use 1-2% iodine to clean the umbilical stump.

### **How to Care III Murrah Buffalo?**

Regular health checks are needed in dairy farming. There are specific ways to manage fevers and diseases in Murrah buffalo.

- The cattle's nose must be examined first; if there is sweating and a runny nose, he probably has an internal fever. Once more, your buffalo is unquestionably sick if she is chewing forcefully and not opening her mouth fully.
- She probably isn't feeling well if a buffalo touches you and doesn't jerk her skin. Excessive udder

hanging in buffaloes is a sign that they are either sick or very old.

• If there is still excrement in the buffalo's private area and it has not been cleaned, there is a chance that its stomach is unwell.

# Wrapping Up!

Unquestionably, one of India's best water buffalo breeds is the Murrah. It produces a substantial amount of milk. Milk Murrah Buffalo meets the milk supply in Haryana and the surrounding areas. It would be best if you took good care of your cattle and calf to get high performance. Use an electrical method to dehorn a calf 8 to 9 days after delivery. Regular deworming of your cattle will maintain their health and fitness.
