
Phillip A. Villanueva, MD, FAANS, a Neurosurgeon with Temple University Hospital

In order to remain up to date in his field, Dr. Villanueva is an active member of the Congress of Neuroscience, the Society Section on Trauma & Critical Care - AANS/CNS, the Pennsylvania Neurosurgical Society, the American Brain Injury Consortium, the Georgia Neurosurgical Society, the Society of Neuroanesthesia and Supportive Care, the Society of Critical Care Medicine, and the National Head Injury Foundation.

Neurosurgery is the medical specialty concerned with the prevention, diagnosis, surgical treatment, and rehabilitation of disorders that affect any portion of the nervous system including the brain, spinal cord, peripheral nerves, and extra-cranial cerebrovascular system. Neurosurgeons are doctors who diagnose and treat problems with the nervous system, often by performing surgery on the brain or spine. They treat strokes, tumors, cervical and lumbar disc disease, infections, and head or spinal cord injuries.

As a testament to his success, Dr. Villanueva has been the recipient of the Best Doctors in America® Award in Neurological Surgery (2019-2020), Dean's List for Patient Satisfaction, Iron Arrow Honor Society, Alpha Omega Alpha, Neurosurgical Resident of the Year Award by Jackson Memorial Medical Center, Frank McCleary Medical Scholarship Award, and Florida Board of Regents Scholarship Award.
