RNs fulfill a variety of job duties. In addition to their primary role of treating and caring for patients, their responsibilities also include educating patients and the public about a variety of medical conditions, as well as providing emotional support and advice to the families of their patients. Other RN job functions include performing diagnostic tests and analyzing results, operating medical equipment, administering medications, recording patients' symptoms and medical histories, as well as assisting with patient rehabilitation and follow-up.

Having worked in the nursing field for more than 25 years, Melissa attributes her success to having compassion for her patients, listening to them, and providing them with the best care she can.
