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"Don't Let Me Go" is the first single of 2023 from multi-talented Latinx artist **Nikky Bourbon** as she speaks from the heart in her latest release, which includes an accompanying music video. Written and produced by Nikky Bourbon, Frederick "StyloLive" Melendez, Sulem, and Ricardo "Rico" Bethancourt from Los Rakas, "Don't Let Me Go" is an emotional journey that captures the essence of a relationship that is too hard to step away from.

"Don't Let Me Go" is based on Bourbon's own experiences, as the song portrays a complex narrative of two people who adore one another but don't know how to express their love in a way that makes the other person feel complete. Bourbon's first love song brings together her many identities through Spanglish lyrics over Afrobeat rhythms and R&B melodies as she weaves a tale of LGBTQ+ romance that causes both pain and pleasure. The video for "Don't Let Me Go" is directed by Isaac Alvarez, and features Bourbon in a sensual new light, showcasing her femininity through soft looks and passionate scenes with Sulem Calderon.

About the single, Bourbon shares, *"Sulem helped write this song as we both have similar passions and views of the world. We wanted to turn it into an LGBTQ+ love story. It naturally clicked for us, so we wanted to use our platforms." "Don't Let Me Go" means "Fighting for love and doing whatever you must to salvage your relationship. It's one of those songs that is more of a feeling than a thought, and the message is to love without judgment of yourself or the other person and to be in the moment with whatever it is that you're dealing with. It's always good; even heartbreak is beautiful."*
