Certified as a Registered Physician in Vascular Interpretation (RPVI), Dr. Abbruzzese is a Fellow of the Society for Vascular Surgery (FSVS) and a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS).

In addition, he is a member of the Florida Medical Society, the Society for Vascular Ultrasound, and the American Medical Association.

Vascular surgery is a surgical subspecialty in which diseases of the vascular system, including the arteries, veins, and lymphatic circulation, are managed by medical therapy, minimally-invasive catheter procedures, and surgical reconstruction. A vascular surgeon diagnoses, treats, and manages conditions in the arteries and veins, also called the blood vessels. These specialists treat a range of health problems, from spider and varicose veins to life-threatening aneurysms, and can help patients manage chronic conditions throughout their lives.

Attributing his success to offering patient-centered care and giving an authentic opinion, Dr. Abbruzzese has authored multiple articles in peer-reviewed journals on various topics in vascular disease, transplantation, and trauma and has presented his findings nationally.
