Holding fellowship status, Dr. Mandybur is a Fellow of the American College of Surgeons (FACS) and a Fellow of the American Association of Neurological Surgeons (FAANS).

Neurology is a branch of medicine dealing with disorders of the nervous system. A neurosurgeon is a physician who specializes in the diagnosis and surgical treatment of disorders of the central and peripheral nervous system, including congenital anomalies, trauma, tumors, vascular disorders, infections of the brain or spine, stroke, or degenerative diseases of the spine.

In his spare time, Dr. Mandybur is known to play a highly competitive game of tennis. He enjoys literature, classical music, and athletics.
