Through the organization's efforts, it has provided over 250,000 meals and over 56,000 nights of shelter in 2022. This Saturday, May 6th, 2023, the photographs taken by the mentee photographers from the winter session will be showcased in an exhibition called "<u>The Bowery Collection</u>" at the Bowery Mission campus at 227 Bowery, New York, New York 10002. The exhibition is free and open to the public from 2:30-4:30 pm. All photos will be for sale, and all proceeds will go directly to the mentee photographers.
