Traditionally, a valid visa could be collected only from the Indian embassy but with this new Electronic Travel Authorization, this can be applied to and collected online. Travelers can get the India e-Visa for three purposes, tourism, business, and medical or transit. Similarly, there is also an option for the Indian Medical e-Visa that can be granted for any medical treatment in the country. The **Indian Medical Visa** allows travelers to enter the country three times. Obtaining a medical visa means the visitor can stay in the country for up to 60 days. If the traveler requires to come to the country more than 3 times, it is possible to apply for a second eMedical Visa. To obtain this visa, the requirements are a scanned color copy of the first (biographical) page of their current passport and a recent passport-style color photo.
