
Traveling to New Zealand Becomes Easier than Ever with the NZeTA

With more and more influx of foreign visitors to the country, the electronic travel authorization or eTA for New Zealand was introduced for the ease of travel, which allows visitors from Visa Waiver countries to come to New Zealand for short stays without the hassle of getting their paper Visas approved.

The online New Zealand Visa or the NZeTA can be applied for by filling out the online application form

Once the application is submitted, it takes the Immigration Officers of the New Zealand Government about 72 hours to decide whether the **New Zealand eTA** (**NZeTA**) would be approved and the applicant is informed of the decision via email. If the Visa is approved, it is also sent to the email id provided by the applicant. Further details are available at https://www.new-zealand-visa.org/new-zealand-eta-visa/.

The NZeTA allows nationals from 60 Visa Waiver countries to travel to **New Zealand Visa-free** for tourism, business, and transit purposes and has a validity of up to 2 years during which travelers can visit the country multiple times. The term 'transit passenger' refers to someone who in order to travel to another country has to go via New Zealand. Transit passengers passing through Auckland International Airport have to obtain a **Transit Visa for New Zealand** to do so. Though most applicants obtain their New Zealand eTA within 24 hours of application and at most three business days, there might at times arise some delay due to technical difficulties. The **Urgent New Zealand Visa** guarantees that individuals who require to visit the country urgently would be allowed to board the plane and enter New Zealand when they reach there.
