“There is no greater care than care demonstrated by Christ-Jesus to humanity (in our view). The brief book begins with our most recent experience (wife’s diagnosis of Stage Four Cancer). Then answers questions for what we call the Care-givers in Christ (CGIC) to nearly all the major issues CGICs encounter. It highlights the topics and provides a resource section in the book and web site where CGIC’s can get additional information.”

According to Dr DavidSon if you have this book as a brief-guide, you have a wealth of CGIC best practices and informational resources to guide you with short-term care, long-term care or after-life care.

“We all must be mindful, regardless of age. Each person will be a care-giver, need care-giving or both. And this book is a major resource for those in the Care-giving experience.”
