Considering this, we have created this helpful write-up to help you download a proper printer driver on your system. Below, we will explain three easy methods to help you have the right driver.

Method 1: Through the Printer Manufacturer's Official Site

It is one of the easiest methods to have printer drivers for free. You need to launch your browser and then go with the steps below. These simple instructions will help you download and install the right driver and software.

First, visit the official site of your printer's manufacturer.

In the next step, navigate to the menu bar and select the Software and Drivers options.

When a new screen appears, tap on the Printer Category and identify your product.

Next, move to the Search box and enter the name of your printer model.

Select your printer from the list of lists displayed on the screen.

Now, select your specific operating system from the printer drivers downloads page.

Tap on the Download icon that is next to the needed printer driver.

Double-click on the downloaded driver setup file.

Follow all the instructions on the installation wizard to install printer driver software.

In the end, restart your computer.

Method 2: Using Device Manager

Windows 11 has a Device Manager tool that helps download and install the printer driver for free. Some of the steps you will need to download printer drivers are as follows:

Move to the Start button on your Windows screen.

In the search box, type in the device manager and hit on the best match result.

Once the Device Manager opens, locate and expand the print/printer queues category.

Now, right-click on your printer and choose the Update Driver option.

Then, you will see two options on the screen. Select the one saying search automatically for updated driver software.

Next, wait until the Windows operating system finds and install the up-to-date driver software for your printer.

After the installation completes, make sure to restart your Windows computer.

Method 3: Via Windows Update Feature

Don't know how to [download printer driver](#)? The Windows update feature will automatically download the latest updates. So, if you have an old printer driver, download the latest updates with the help of the steps given below.

Click on the Start logo on your Windows or press the Windows key.

Now, open Settings, which looks like a grey gear icon.

On the other hand, you can press Win + I keys.

After that, click Update and Security next to the large refresh icon.

Once Windows updates find any update, it automatically downloads and installs the latest printer driver.

Or, you can tap on View optional updates and tab on the arrow next to the Driver Updates. When you discover your printer's driver, click on it to select and then tap the download and install tab.

Printer drivers are essential software that helps Windows communicate with the device. When there is an incompatible or outdated driver, the printer and PC can't function together.
