
George J. Graf, MD, an Anesthesiologist with Westside Anesthesia and West Valley Medical Aesthetics

Furthermore, he is board certified in internal medicine by the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

With a long history in medication management and opioid detoxification, Dr. Graf developed a unique and very successful method for managing opioid withdrawal, "Ultra Rapid Opioid Detoxification."

Among his professional affiliations, he is an active member of the American Society of Anesthesiologists, the American Society of Addiction Medicine, the American Society of Interventional Pain Physicians, the California Society of Addiction Medicine, and the International Spine Intervention Society.

Anesthesiology is the medical specialty concerned with the total perioperative care of patients before, during, and after surgery. It encompasses anesthesia, intensive care medicine, critical emergency medicine, and pain medicine. Anesthesiologists have the primary responsibility of monitoring the patient's vital signs during surgery.

With a considerable academic history, Dr. Graf has been an Assistant Professor at both Yale and UCLA. He has also authored over a dozen books and articles while producing a considerable amount of medical research over the last three decades.
