Vascular surgery is a surgical subspecialty in which vascular diseases involving the arteries, veins, or lymphatic vessels, are managed by medical therapy, minimally invasive catheter procedures, and surgical reconstruction. A vascular doctor, vascular specialist, or vascular surgeon treats vascular

problems. They treat a wide range of issues that involve the arteries and veins, such as blocked or narrow blood vessels.

A devoted husband and father, Dr. and Mrs. Farrugia have been blessed with 4 beautiful children - Samantha, Vincent, Brianna, and Thomas, and an energetic Labradoodle named Private. They are training in ballroom dancing, having been certified up to Bronze Level 3 in several dances.
