What makes us unique is we're creating the incentive to shop local and buy local through really cool uses of technology. True, the prospect of cash and other prizes doesn't hurt either."

The crowdfunding campaign method the company is using is termed <u>fixed funding</u>. According to Indiegogo, if they do not reach their goal, the contributor's entire amount "will be refunded by Indiegogo within 5-7 business days."
