In 2002, Dr. Cabassa-Latoni became a Diplomate of the American Board of Pediatric Dentistry. He served as Department Head, Clinic Director, and Chief of Dental Services at various Naval Hospitals. In 2009, he became the top pediatric dentist for the U.S. Navy as the Specialty Advisor for Pediatric Dentistry to the Navy Surgeon General.

After retirement from the Naval Service, following 28 years of service, Dr. Cabassa-Latoni went to private practice in Southern Spain after achieving his dental boards. He then relocated to the United States, settling in Florida.

An Honorary Life Member of the International Association of Dental Students, Dr. Cabassa-Latoni is also an active member of the American Academy of Pediatric Dentistry, the American Dental Association, the College of Dental Surgeons of Spain, and the College of Dental Surgeons of Puerto Rico. He has lectured in more than eleven countries.

Pediatric dentistry is the branch of dentistry dealing with children from birth through adolescence. A pediatric dentist specializes in the diagnosis and treatment of the dental problems of children from infancy to young adulthood. They usually care for special needs patients as well.
