Benjamin Walker, director at LDA Design, the Executive Landscape Architects, emphasises the garden's resilience, saying, "The gardens require minimal maintenance and, a year since planting, are now thriving."

Since its opening in October 2022, Battersea Power Station has emerged as London's premier leisure, shopping, and luxury living destination.
