A revamped sharing menu simplifies access management, email, and link sharing, and file collaboration with external partners. Moreover, a dedicated button on the Home tab facilitates easy installation and access to Office add-ins in Word, Excel, and PowerPoint, streamlining workflow integration.

Excel for web users will also benefit from the update, with an integrated Share menu dialogue box and a dedicated Office add-ins button. These additions enhance productivity and provide a seamless experience across all platforms.
