
Tayna Miller, PMHNP-BC, a Psychiatric-Mental Health Nurse Practitioner with Banyan Wellness Center Maui

PMHNPs diagnose, conduct therapy, and prescribe medications for patients who have psychiatric disorders, medical organic brain disorders, or substance abuse problems. They are licensed to provide emergency psychiatric services, psychosocial and physical assessment of their patients, treatment plans, and patient care. They may also serve as consultants or as educators for families and staff.

The key to Tayna's success can be attributed to recognizing a vital need within the community and having the desire to address and fulfill that need.
