As part of his training, he received his Doctor of Medicine Degree from the University of Texas at Houston Medical School and also completed a one-year internship in general surgery at the same institution.

Board certified, Dr. Vuu is a Diplomate of the American Board of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery (ABOMS). The ABOMS ensures that Diplomates meet the standards of training, education, and professionalism through the certification process.

Actively engaged in several professional organizations that reflect his commitment to the field of dentistry and oral surgery, Dr. Vuu is a dedicated member of the Texas Dental Association, the American Dental Association, the American Medical Association, the Houston Society of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeons, the American Association of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon, the Greater Houston Dental Society, where he serves on the New Dentist Committee, as well as the Houston Asian American Dental Society, where he serves as the Community Volunteer Director.
