
Joseph Sokiri Dumba, MD, a Family Physician with Methodist Physicians Clinic Indian Hills

Subsequently, Dr. Dumba pursued higher education at the university level and earned a double major in Zoology and Molecular Biology. He then joined the University of Washington School of Medicine, achieving his Medical Degree in 2001.

To further his medical training, Dr. Dumba relocated to the Midwest, where he completed his residency in family medicine at the Mayo School of Graduate Medical Training in 2004.

Board certified in family medicine, he is a Diplomate of the American Board of Family Medicine (ABFM). The ABFM is a non-profit, independent medical association of American physicians who practice family medicine and its sub-specialties.

Among his professional affiliations, Dr. Dumba is an active member of the American Medical Association, the American Academy of Family Physicians, and the Nebraska Academy of Family Physicians.

Family medicine is a medical specialty devoted to comprehensive health care for people of all ages. The specialist is called a family physician or family doctor. A family physician is often the first person a patient sees when seeking healthcare services. They examine and treat patients with a wide range of conditions and refer those with serious ailments to a specialist or appropriate facility.

Beyond his medical practice, Dr. Dumba is the Founder of The Healing Kadi Foundation, a non-profit organization that has been providing medical services to the people of South Sudan since 2009.
