He then completed a fellowship in minimally invasive laparoscopic surgery at Lutheran Medical Center and served as a surgical attending and clinical assistant professor, specializing in general, minimally invasive, and trauma surgery.

In 2009, Dr. Dronsky joined Surgical Associates of New York, LLP which was regrouped as General and Laparoscopic Surgeons of New York, LLP in 2012. Now, he works alongside Drs. Sergei Dolgoplov and Roman Grinberg at Lenox Hill Surgeons, LLP.

General surgery is a surgical specialty that focuses on abdominal contents including the esophagus, stomach, small bowel, colon, liver, pancreas, gallbladder, appendix and bile ducts, and often the thyroid gland. A general surgeon performs a wide range of abdominal surgeries for many forms of intestinal and abdominal wall neoplasms, gallbladder disease, gastric and pancreatic disease. They follow the patient through critical care and surgical recovery all the way to outpatient care.

Attributing his success to hard work and the support of his co-workers, Dr. Dronsky has been the recipient of the Golden Apple Award for Excellence in Medical Student Teaching.
