Whilst the process of singulation & sorting of containers may seem mundane, the purpose behind R4C is far more powerful in creating meaningful transitional employment for returning citizens allowing them to rebuild their lives & become contributing members of society."

R4C provides fully inclusive employment with no barriers or judgment based on criminal history, race,

religion, sexual identity, or ethnicity while at the same time reducing environmental impact resulting from waste and playing an integral part in Victoria's circular economy.

R4C commences operations on Wednesday, 1 November, at 116 Furner Ave, Bell Park (North Geelong), and will be open during the following hours:
