Playing a pivotal role in medical education, Dr. Costales is an Assistant Professor of Clinical Orthopedic Surgery at the Perelman School of Medicine at the University of Pennsylvania, where he imparts knowledge and guidance to medical students, orthopaedic surgery residents, and fellows. In addition to his clinical practice, Dr. Costales is actively engaged in academic research and is a candidate member of the American Academy of Orthopaedic Surgeons (AAOS) and the American Association of Hip and Knee Surgeons (AAHKS).
