Ministry Wields the Power of Technologies for a Global Campaign and Greater Authority

Given his view, when asked about the point of letting the public know about the accomplishment, DavidSon is clear.

"We're called upon to let our good works shine, specifically so those who are benefiting will recognize and honor our God, and for all others to take note. There is also the matter of accountability to supporters and sponsors. And it is also important to foster a spirit of goodwill in the general public. As an example, we are adamantly against the popular approach of using our ministry to support a partisan political agenda, Sure, we reserve the right to warn the public of the danger and what we see as harmful conduct. But we're not on some platform against groups of people who do, think, or believe differently from us. My point is that we're not living on hatred and divisiveness as demagogues. We're difference makers and millions respond."

DavidSon is also resolute when asked about what separates Amazing Things The Church from the traditional church experience.

"Let me be clear. We're not an alternative. We are an additional asset to our Faith. We support local churches in their efforts. As you know most are centrally focused on Sunday. That is their 'big' day. Lacking the resources and/or attendees, it's not tenable for masses of churches to operate daily. We stand but also provide support where they do not have resources or capability. We operate with availability and even interjection each day, 24/7/365. We feature speed in what we produce, the quantity of what we produce, global coverage, expansive programming, and social-media design, and we make a strategic effort to ensure our pastoral team has exposure as well as myself. The heart of what we deliver is relevant Biblical Faith-life and practical content daily!!!

Others can believe or not believe whatever they desire. However, we celebrate this time of year. And we do not avoid the very central meaning of Christmas for us. It's a time representing hope, encouragement, and even new life. And we spend every day and hour of every year presenting this opportunity for a new life in Christ Jesus. And it is an empirical fact, that millions worldwide respond. The results of what we do would be impossible without the technologies. These are underutilized, misunderstood, and even demonized by many in the religious community. But we leverage the technologies for what we believe to be the greatest cause on the planet. Amen!"
