For advanced stages of osteoarthritis, Dr. Surange highlighted that while knee replacement surgeries are a viable option, stem cell therapy could be a better alternative in the early stages. He also mentioned Cooled RF technology as a suitable option for pain reduction in patients not fit for knee replacement surgery.

Dr. Surange concluded by addressing various aspects of knee arthritis treatment and management, including the benefits of walking, suitable exercises, and the comparison of stem cell therapy with knee replacement surgery.
