
Kurt Tauer, MD, a Hematologist-Oncologist with West Cancer Center & Research Institute

He then went on to perform his residency in internal medicine at Baptist Memorial Hospital, followed by his fellowship in medical oncology at Memorial Sloan-Kettering Cancer Center.

Board certified in internal medicine and medical oncology, Dr. Tauer is recognized as a Diplomate of the American Board of Internal Medicine (ABIM). The ABIM is a physician-led, non-profit, independent evaluation organization driven by doctors who want to achieve higher standards for better care in a rapidly changing world.

A renowned expert in the study and treatment of lung, breast, prostate, colon, and melanoma cancers, Dr. Tauer has served on the National Comprehensive Cancer Network Panel for Non-Small Cell Lung Cancer.

In addition to being a Fellow of the American College of Physicians, he is a member of both the Memphis Medical Society and the American Society of Clinical Oncology.

Hematology is the branch of medicine concerned with the study of the cause, prognosis, treatment, and prevention of diseases related to blood. Oncology is a branch of medicine that deals with the prevention, diagnosis, and treatment of cancer. A hematologist-oncologist is a physician who specializes in the diagnosis, treatment, or prevention of blood diseases and cancers such as iron-deficiency anemia, hemophilia, sickle-cell disease, leukemia, and lymphoma.
