Initially deep, later evocative and inspiring, ultimately driven and devoted to its sense of freedom from the norm, the modern punk explosion of both precision and passion, fearless in its depiction whilst maintaining that crucial aspect of entertainment and musicianship as a means of connecting with and impressing a modern audience.
