
## Raymond L. Singer, MD, a Cardiothoracic Surgeon with Jefferson Health

His involvement in professional societies extends to holding positions of leadership, including Past-President of the Pennsylvania Association for Thoracic Surgery and Past-President of the Lehigh County Medical Society.

His extensive career includes notable roles at Lehigh Valley Health Network (LVHN) from 1992 to 2019. During his tenure at LVHN, he served as the physician-in-chief for the LVHN Special Surgery Institute, highlighting his leadership and commitment to the highest standards of patient care. Additionally, he held the positions of Chief of Cardiothoracic Surgery and Vice Chair of Quality and Patient Safety for the LVHN Department of Surgery.

Beyond his clinical and administrative roles, Dr. Singer contributes to the field through his service on the Editorial Board for American Health and Drug Benefits, under the guidance of Dr. David Nash, Dean of the Jefferson College of Population Health.

Cardiothoracic surgery is the field of medicine involved in the surgical treatment of organs inside the thorax. Cardiothoracic surgeons are medical doctors who specialize in surgical procedures inside the thorax, which may involve the heart, lungs, esophagus, and other organs in the chest. Alongside performing surgery, they also diagnose and treat diseases of these organs. Dr. Singer's focus is on heart valve surgery, coronary artery bypass, and atrial fibrillation surgery.
