His professional journey led him to his first attending physician position at the State University of New York Upstate Medical Center, where Dr. Mendenhall gained insights into phenomena like lake-effect snow. Eager for new experiences, he later relocated to the opposite end of the United States.

Board-certified in interventional radiology, Dr. Mendenhall is recognized as a Diplomate of the American Board of Radiology (ABR). The ABR is a not-for-profit physician-led organization that oversees the certification and ongoing professional development of specialists in diagnostic radiology, interventional radiology, radiation oncology, and medical physics.

Among his professional affiliations, Dr. Mendenhall is an active member of the Society of Interventional Radiology and the Association of Program Directors in Radiology.

Interventional radiology is a medical specialization that involves performing a range of imaging and therapeutic procedures to diagnose and treat many clinical problems. Vascular & interventional radiologists focus on diseases of the blood vessels and lymphatic system but also treat other conditions such as cancer and infertility. They perform minimally invasive treatments that have less risk, pain, and recovery time compared to open surgery.
