Sierra Subaru of Monrovia, recognizing the significance of community connections, emphasized their commitment to positively impact the lives of young individuals beyond the road. This was demonstrated by a thoughtful gesture at the event, where students received a grab bag containing uplifting messages and self-care items to keep them motivated as they exited.
