The mentors were invested in trainees, and everyone enjoyed coming to work."

As a leader in the field of addiction psychiatry, Dr. Swift's research interests focus on the clinical implications of interventions for addicted patients. She is currently mentoring residents on various projects, including exploring the treatment of psychosis in methamphetamine users, addressing disparities in access to dual diagnosis care based on race, and examining the judicious use of benzodiazepines in the outpatient setting.

Outside of her demanding career, she finds solace in spending time with her three children and engaging in activities such as cooking, hiking, and socializing with family and friends. Her compassion extends beyond the hospital walls, as evidenced by her past involvement in fostering over 50 rescue dogs during her residency.
