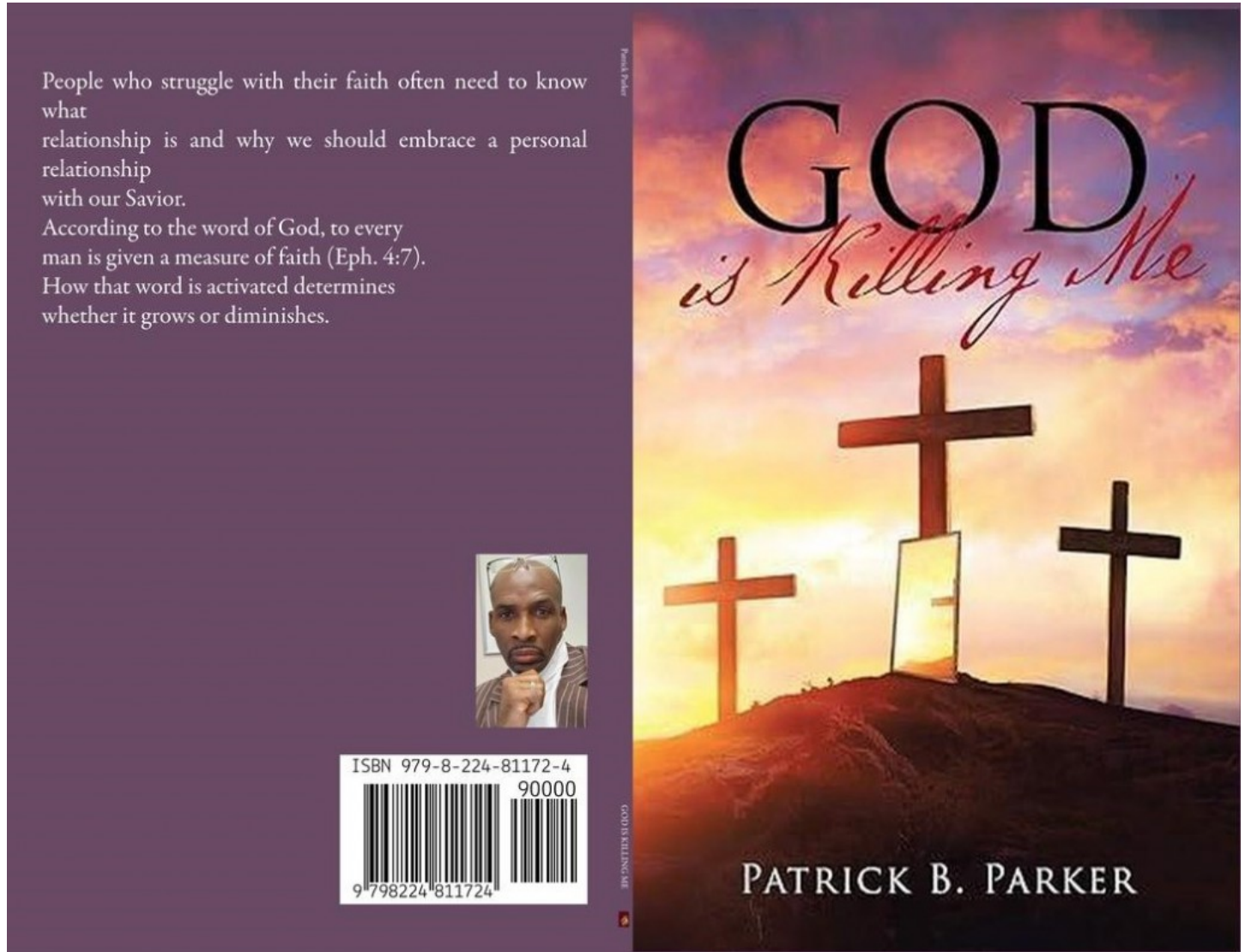


## God Is Killing Me is provocative , bold and stirring the waters of believers and non-believers alike.
