

All Things Aviation In June!

So why should we celebrate these great names in June? There are so many aspects to aviation, and we found some interesting key dates that are linked with many of the Amazing Aviators in this inspirational title. Starting with the Montgolfier brothers and their wonderful hot-air balloons – these were first launched on 4 June 1783, and many others built on their work. William Boeing's Model 1 (B & W Seaplane) flew for the first time on 15 June 1916.

Women have made significant contributions to early aviation. This title explores the stories of amazing aviators such as Jacqueline Auriol and Amy Johnson. Also included is Amelia Earhart - she became the first woman to fly across the Atlantic Ocean as a passenger on 17 June 1928, and later flew non-stop solo over the same ocean!

Frank Whittle was born on 1 June 1907. His ingenuity led to him developing the jet engine – where would we be without this today? His story is well worth discussing.

Stories For Aviation Conversations

The Wright Brothers' amazing innovations are well documented, and their breakthrough is world famous. However, substantial evidence shows that Richard Pearse, a New Zealander, built and flew a powered fixed-wing plane before them, and maybe Gustave Whitehead also. Such aviation mysteries make for intriguing exploration.

Many of these aviators had short lives. On 11 January 1935, Amelia Earhart flew solo over the Pacific Ocean. If you could meet Amelia Earhart, what would you ask her? What first inspired her to fly? How did she come to make this momentous journey? Take some time to find out what there is to know about her fascinating life story, told from her own perspective. She pilots you through her life as a high achiever, breaking altitude records and hearts, as well as paving the way for a new generation of gogetting women aviators.

Charles Kingsford Smith, Raymonde de Laroche and Yuri Gagarin died at relatively young ages in plane crashes. Others, who lived to tell the tale, often did not write a biography. The background to their great achievements is not fully known.
