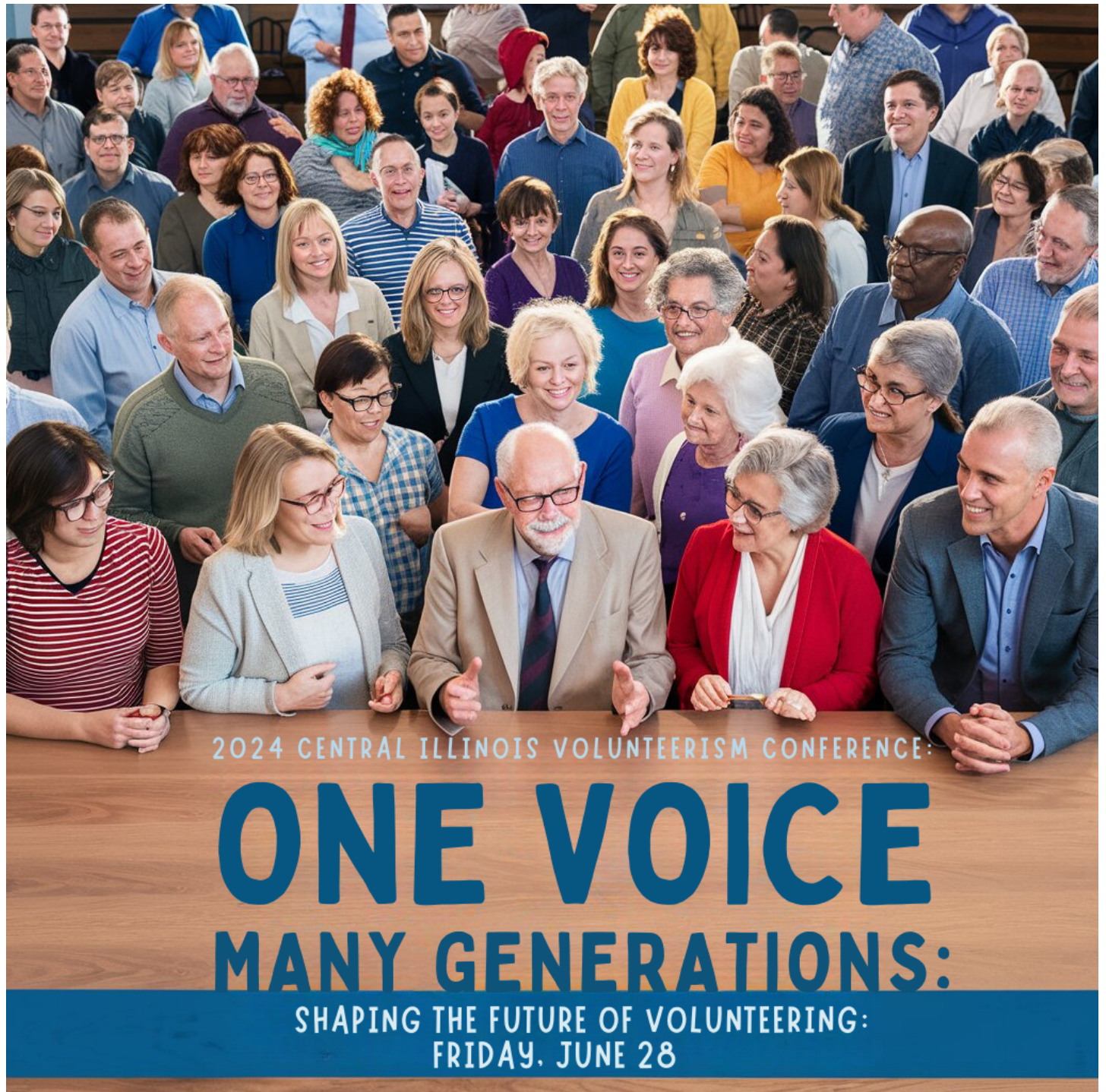


2024 Central Illinois Volunteerism Conference: "One Voice, Many Generations: Shaping the Future of Volunteering"
