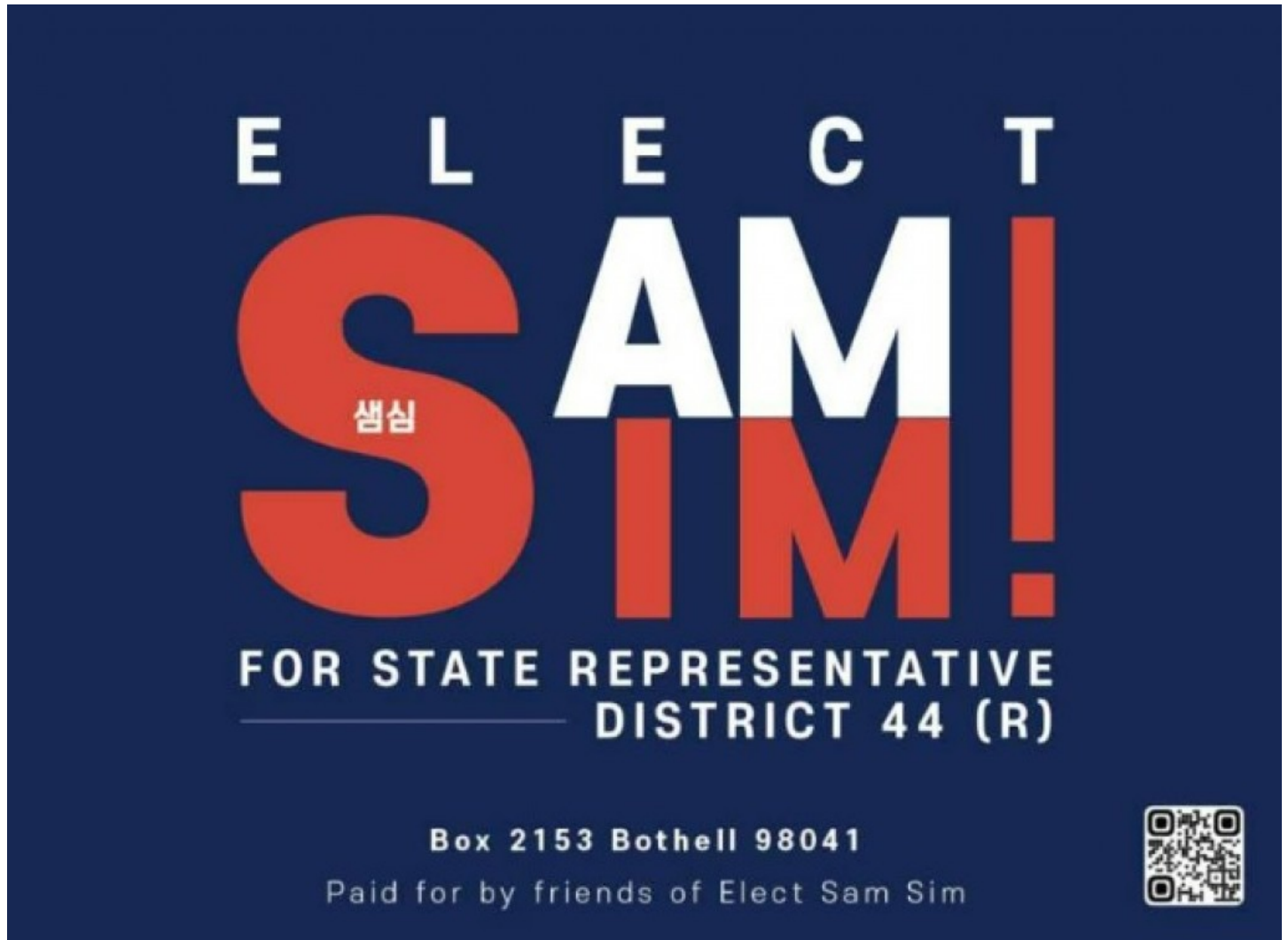


## Sam Sim Announces Candidacy for State Representative Legislative District 44 - First Asian American Ever to Run
