- Contain a catchy title that reflects its key idea.
- Be delivered in *.MOV, *.MPEG4, *.MP4, or *.AVI format.

Second Step

Use Google Drive or Dropbox to upload your video. Please don't set the file for public access before StudyCorgi starts collecting submissions.

Third Step

Write an email to scholarship@studycorgi.com with "StudyCorgi Video Scholarship Submission" as the subject. In your email, include the following information in this particular order:

- The link to the video that you've uploaded (access to the file should be set to anyone who has the link).
- A screenshot confirming your subscriptions to StudyCorgi's YouTube channel.
- A screenshot confirming that the Scholarship video description was shared on social media.
- A thumbnail of your choice (this one is optional).
- Proof that you are a current high school, college, or university student.
- Your answer to the question: "How did you learn about the StudyCorgi Scholarship?"

We won't accept your submission if anything from the list above is missing.

Stage 2
