In addition, she holds prestigious leadership roles as Co-Director of the Child and Adolescent Committee for the National Council for Mental Wellbeing, Medical Director Institute, as well as Board Member-at-large for the American Association for Community Psychiatry.

Her past service includes being the Former Program Director of the University of Maryland Child and Adolescent Psychiatry Fellowship, Past President of the Caucus of Black Psychiatrists of the American Psychiatric Association, and Vice-Chair for the Council for Children Adolescents and Their Families.

A Diplomate of the American Board of Psychiatry and Neurology and a Distinguished Fellow of the American Psychiatric Association (DFAPA), Dr. Gordon is board-certified in both general and child and adolescent psychiatry.
