She served on the faculty at the University of Rochester for 11 years and held the position of Chief of Neonatology at the University at Buffalo for another 11 years. Dr. Ryan also made significant contributions as the Director of the Neonatal-Perinatal Medicine Fellowship Program at both institutions. In 2011, she was recruited as Chair of Pediatrics at the Medical University of South Carolina in Charleston, where she spent a total of eight years before joining UH Rainbow in 2019.

Board certified in pediatrics and neonatal-perinatal medicine, Dr. Ryan's professional affiliations include being a Fellow of the American Academy of Pediatrics and a founding Fellow of the American Thoracic Society. She is an active member of the Society for Pediatric Research and the Perinatal Research Society and serves as an Associate Editor for the Journal of Perinatology and Pediatric Pulmonology.

With approximately 200 peer-reviewed articles and textbook chapters, and numerous presentations at national conferences, Dr. Ryan is recognized as a leading voice in neonatal cardiopulmonary research. Her contributions extend to national initiatives, having served on National Institutes of Health study sections and participated in NIH Workshops.
