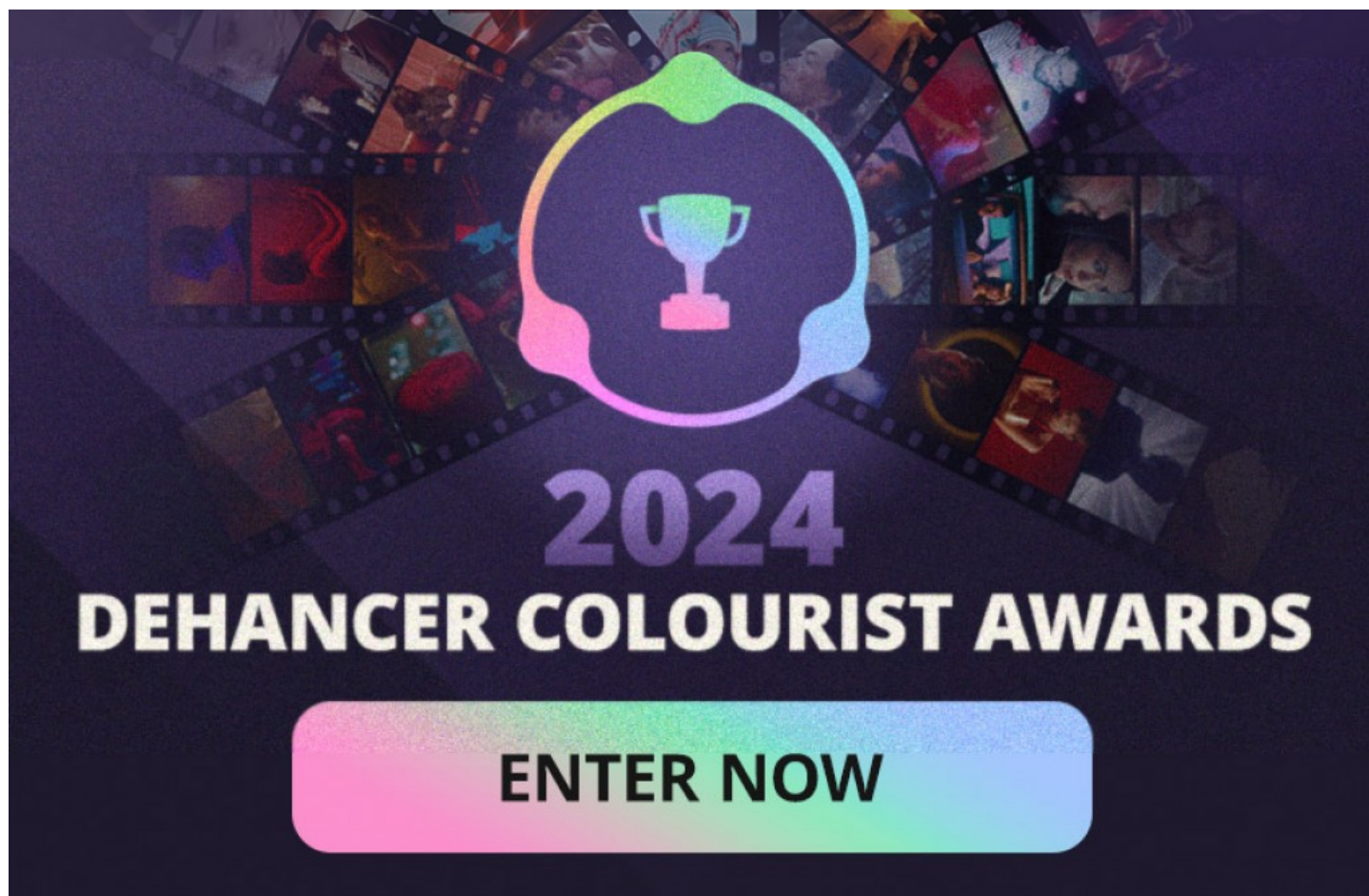


Dehancer announces the Colourist Awards 2024
