His leadership extends to various roles within the cancer center, and he has recently been appointed Chairman of the American College of Surgeons Commission on Cancer for Louisiana.

Furthermore, Dr. Lyons has contributed to the scientific community as an author and co-author of multiple peer-reviewed journal articles and textbook chapters, and he is involved in several cancer clinical trials, both locally and nationally.
