
The Enchanting World of Mysore Paintings at Exotic India Art

Granted the GI tag in 2007, Mysore paintings are an integral part of the larger sphere of Indian art. Loved by art collectors for their unparalleled beauty, soft color palette, and traditional themes, Mysore

paintings are found in homes as ritual and sacred symbols as well as in the treasures of art connoisseurs across the globe who truly appreciate the masterclass of Mysore art.
