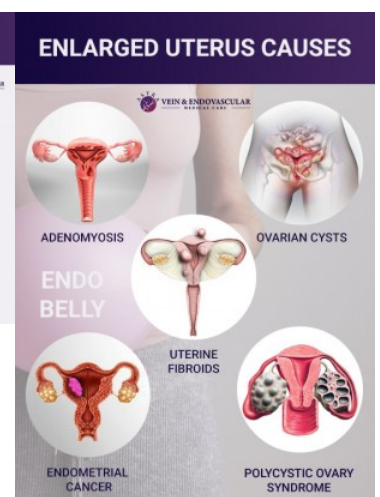
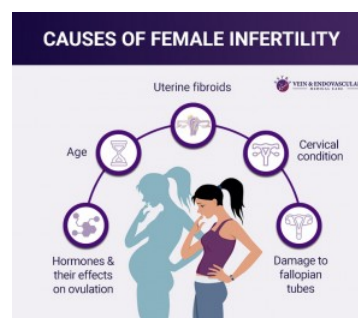
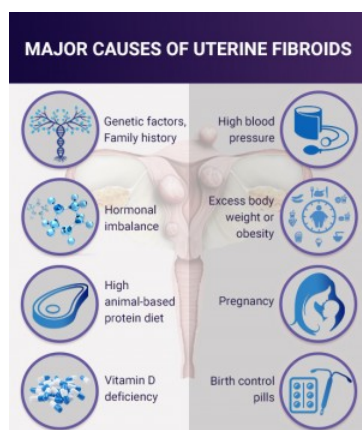

WHAT ARE EFFECTIVE MEDICAL TREATMENTS FOR VARICOSE VEINS?

ASTRA VEIN & ENDOVASCULAR

1) MEDICINE
Drugs that increase blood flow, such as aspirin, can help heal the leg ulcers associated with varicose veins.

2) SCLEROTHERAPY
During this procedure, your vein specialist injects a foamy solution into your varicose vein. It causes your vein to scar, shrivel up, and close.





3) ENDOVENOUS LASER ABLATION
Without using incisions or needles, your vein doctor shoots a beam of laser light into smaller varicose veins to seal them.

4) RADIOFREQUENCY ABLATION
This minimally invasive technique improves your blood flow. Your varicose veins specialist directs heat into the vein with the help of a catheter. The procedure collapses the vein from the inside.





5) AMBULATORY PHLEBOTOMY
Performed with local anesthesia, this procedure is a minimally invasive technique to remove your varicose veins through a succession of tiny pricks, which produce minimal scarring.

6) SURGERY
Varicose vein surgery may involve surgery if your pain and other symptoms are severe enough, but it's always the last resort.





7) LIGATION
In this procedure, your vein specialist ties off the vein, so blood can no longer flow through it.

8) ENDOSCOPIC SURGERY
For this procedure, your vein surgeon inserts a thin tiny camera into your leg, so he can close and surgically remove it.
