

Elon Musk Joked it would be Pointless to Kill Joe Biden or Kamala Harris

Find out what the richest man and pro-Trump supporter Elon Musk said when it comes to the prospects of the assassination of Vice President Kamala Harris and Joe Biden.

He is Donald Trump's supporter, perhaps pathetic but he knows how to create a controversy. On Monday, Musk joked pretty terribly when it came down to the prospect of the assassination of Joe Biden or Vice President Kamala Harris. After talking with conservative pundit Tucker Carlson, Musk made a wise decision to delete the post from X, formerly known as Twitter which is also owned by Musk. Later on, he posted, "I made a joke, which I realize I deleted, which was like, nobody's even bothering to try to kill Kamala, because it's pointless."

Musk further added, "What do you achieve?" he continued, suggesting the vice president would be replaced by another "puppet" and emphasizing the fact that "Nobody's trying to kill Joe Biden. It would be pointless." These comments were made during Carlson's show which is broadcast via X. The show started after Elon Musk was fired from Fox News back in 2023. Carlson strongly agreed with Musk and said he was "totally right," without further questioning. Last month, Musk made sure to quote a Pro-Trump account which reads, "Why do they want to kill Donald Trump?" and the CEO responded "And no one is even trying to assassinate Biden/Kamala."

These comments came right after the second attempt of assassination which was stopped by the Secret Service agents and was plotted while he was enjoying his time at the West Palm Beach golf club. With

this cinematic scenario, Musk further explained “Some people interpreted it as though I was calling for people to assassinate her, but I was like... doesn’t it seem strange that no one’s even bothered to try?” which put more gasoline on the fire. The conversation between Carlson and Musk currently has 15 million views and the talk about killing Harris starts within 45 seconds.
