They performed live and released one album ('One Day a New Horizon') between 1981 and 1984. In 2006, after discovering that One Day a New Horizon had a strong following in Japan, Rory released two solo albums ('Passing Decades', 'A Question of Expression') in addition to a second Protos album ('The Noble Pauper's Grave). After a career as a research professor, he retired in 2021. He is now writing music again.

In 2024, he released his first single ('Ghost Rap') and a third album with Protos ('The Infinite Horizon').
