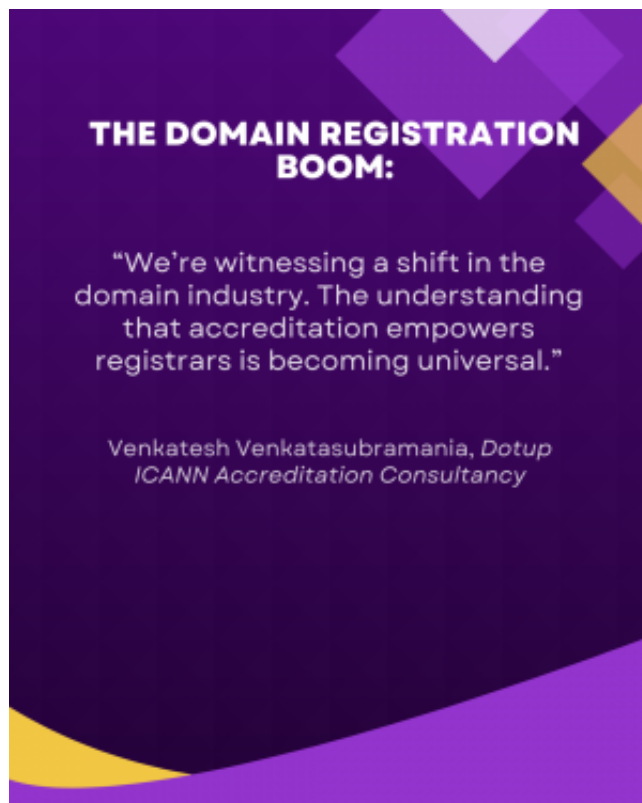
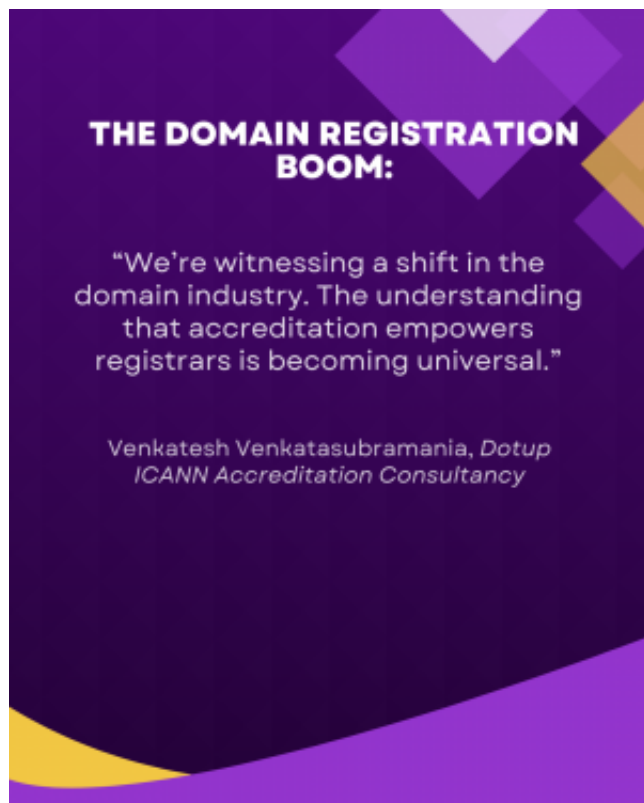
The Future of Domain Registration
