

Bitcoin about to break \$100,000 as Retail Crypto Interest Surges

From Memes to Movements, the rise of \$Roxie Highlights a Global Call for Change



London, United Kingdom Nov 25, 2024 ([Issuewire.com](https://www.issuewire.com)) - Bitcoin is about to shatter the \$100,000 milestone, signalling an unprecedented boom in retail interest in cryptocurrencies. Amid this surge, the market is seeing the rapid proliferation of meme coins, with thousands of new tokens created daily. While some projects reach staggering market caps—like \$Pnut, a quirky coin inspired by New York's famed slain squirrel, now valued in the billions—many are outright scams, preying on the hopes of individuals seeking life-changing fortunes.

In this saturated landscape, it's becoming increasingly difficult for new projects to stand out, as most coins merely imitate existing trends. However, a rare exception is \$Roxie, a meme coin born out of tragedy but powered by a passionate community striving to make a difference.

\$Roxie: A Meme Coin with a Mission

\$Roxie, available on the Solana blockchain is managed by the community and represented on X as <https://x.com/RoxieRedPanda>, the project draws attention to the tragic story of Roxie, a baby red panda at Edinburgh Zoo who died last week from fright caused by fireworks. Her death followed the recent loss of her mother, leaving a poignant mark on animal lovers worldwide who are hearing her story. Roxie inspiring change

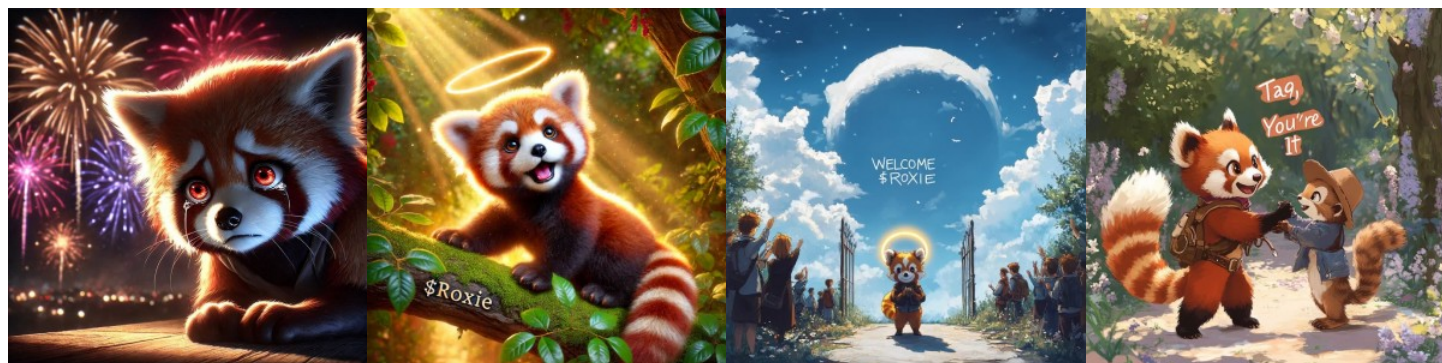
Roxie's story has captured hearts across the globe, prompting international media coverage and inspiring action. A petition to increase controls on fireworks—cited as the trigger for Roxie's death—has amassed over 45,000 signatories, with a goal of 50,000. The petition aims to pressure the Scottish and UK governments to prioritise animal welfare in policy decisions.

For context, this initiative echoes an earlier petition, signed by over 1 million people, calling for stricter regulations on fireworks due to their impact on vulnerable individuals and animals. That petition was submitted to the UK Parliament earlier this month, underscoring the urgency of this issue.
