First Mr. Gay World Puerto Rico, Returns to Reading, PA, to Mobilize Latino & LGBTQ+ Voters for Kamala Harris

The meeting underscored the importance of community involvement and encouraged local residents to participate in the democratic process, rallying support for Kamala Harris's vision of equality, justice, and inclusion.

"As a Puerto Rican and LGBTQ+ advocate, Kamala Harris's vision of equity and inclusion deeply resonates with me and my roots here in Reading," Ortiz shared. "I want every voter, especially Latinos and LGBTQ+ individuals, to understand the power of their vote.

Ortiz's canvassing efforts are supported by his involvement in national phone banks, targeting key issues like economic equality, social justice, and environmental reform. His commitment adds to a grassroots network working across swing states to increase voter engagement and turnout.

A Record of Advocacy and Leadership

Juan Luis Ortiz has long been a community leader and advocate for LGBTQ+ rights and Latino empowerment. In 2013, he made history as the first individual to represent Puerto Rico at the Mr. Gay World Pageant in Antwerp, Belgium, breaking barriers and promoting visibility for LGBTQ+ Puerto Ricans on an international stage.
