

US President Trump and Russian President Putin Spoke about the War

It seems like Trump is back in action with his brisk moves of communicating with Russian President Putin regarding the Ukraine war situation and military funding.

According to a source, the President asked Putin not to escalate the situation regarding the Russia-Ukraine war. While this came out on Sunday, it is also said that former President Joe Biden is going to urge Trump not to give up on Kyiv. Trump and Putin talked in recent days, but Trump also talked with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskiy last Wednesday.

President Trump has criticized the scale and expenditure of the US Military for the support of Kyiv. It seems like he took a vow to end the war quickly. However, it could be a strategic move. Trump's communications director, Steven Cheung said, "We do not comment on private calls between President Trump and other world leaders", when he asked about the phone call between the Presidents. The Russian Embassy has not revealed anything either.

After defeating Vice President Kamala Harris, Republican Trump is about to take office on Jan. 20. According to the White House, former president Joe Biden has invited Trump to join the Oval Office on Wednesday. Jake Sullivan, U.S. National Security Adviser said that their communication will be based on the international situation in Europe, Asia, and the Middle East while they will also focus on the peaceful transfer of power. Sullivan said, "I'm not here to put forward a specific legislative proposal. President Biden will make the case that we do need ongoing resources for Ukraine beyond the end of

his term." Washington has made a huge amount of funding in support of Ukraine and Trump has repeatedly criticized it. Now all that remains is to see whether the war ends quickly or not.
