- **Ngamba Island Chimpanzee Sanctuary: A Haven for Wildlife Conservation**

Ammar Jali also has the Ngamba Island Chimpanzee Sanctuary as a top priority. Located on Lake Victoria, Ngamba Island is home to a sanctuary dedicated to the care and rehabilitation of rescued chimpanzees. Today, Jali notes, visitors can stand at the Speke Monument, take photos, and embark on boat rides across the iconic river and into Lake Victoria.

"There's something magical about standing at the Source of the Nile," Jali says. "You're not only witnessing the beginning of the world's longest river but also connecting with a piece of history."

- **Rwenzori Mountains National Park: The 'Mountains of the Moon'**

Lastly in Ammar Jali's list is the Rwenzori Mountains National Park. For those who love hiking and breathtaking vistas, the Rwenzori Mountains, often referred to as the "Mountains of the Moon," provide an unparalleled experience. This UNESCO World Heritage Site, Jali says, features snow-capped peaks, stunning glaciers, and diverse vegetation that ranges from tropical rainforest to alpine meadows.

"The Rwenzori Mountains are perfect for travelers looking for a mix of challenge and beauty," Jali shares. "The views from the trails are incredible, and the biodiversity is unmatched."
